It also became apparent that we were competing with a number of other magic conventions that all fall within weeks of each other. All of these factors seemed to be leading to something I have ended up calling, "convention fatigue."

To that end, the TAOM 2025 Convention is being canceled this year. Please know that if you have already registered for the convention, your registration fees will be returned to you in the coming days. I regret that we cannot continue the tradition this year, but I also cannot guarantee the delivery of a convention you have come to expect.

In the meantime, plans are underway for the TAOM 2026 Convention in Houston, Texas, with the return of the model of having the local club host the annual convention. This should provide the funding and manpower needed to insure the successful delivery of our time-honored conventions.

While we will not have the convention in 2025, the TAOM Board does not want the year to pass without some kind of celebration for the art of magic. We are looking at alternatives, instead of a formal convention, such as an informal gathering and/or picnic. I will reach back out when/if those plans become finalized.






Sam Sawyers Lecturer





Special Guest: Louis Daniel

"The Unofficial Official TAOM Illustrator"

At 94, Louis Daniel is older than the "founding fathers!" In fact, he has survived them all - the TAOM founders, that is. Louis is TAOM's "unofficial official illustrator," His commercial art has been a fixture in North Texas for more than seventy years, and literally, the crates of his work earmarked for the archives of the Fort Worth Public Library is a fitting testimony to the place he holds in the Southwestern culture.

Louis began illustrations for the TAOM as early as the 1950's. The Fort Worth entrepreneur, hotelier, and 9th International President of the IBM and founder of the Fort Worth Magicians Club, A. Renerick "Ren" Clark approached him in 1953 about a new logo for the fledgling Texas Association of Magicians.

"Ren didn't much care for the existing logo and asked me to design a new one," says Louis. He says he's tweaked it over the years, but that same logo still accompanies the eight decades-long history of the "Lone Star" association.

Over the many years, Louis Daniel would become the "go-to" illustrator for the TAOM. "I can't tell you how many cards, program covers, posters – scads of posters! – portraits, trick illustrations, and even metal tokens I have created over the years for our Texas organization."

Louis's office features a gallery of the "who's who" of American twentieth-century magical entertainment. He's captured the faces of so many of the iconic entertainers of the period. "I'll never forget when Harry Blackstone, Jr. came in my office one day," Louis reflects, "and asked me to design the cover for the 1985 commemorative program, featuring my portrait of his father, Harry Blackstone, Sr. on what would have been his 100th birthday. There's Ren, of course, but also there's Doug Henning, Bev Bergeron, Seigfried and Roy, even David Copperfield—I can't remember them all.

Louis is proud of his contributions to the TAOM-all the long hours, a labor of love over the many years, and all volunteered! "I'm so happy that I could make a contribution. I'm especially happy that I'm able to attend the TAOM Showcase!" says Louis. "I'm not getting any younger, and you just never know! So, thanks to everyone!"
